**(B) GUIDELINES FOR PPT PRESENTATION OF DISSERTATION**

**In the PPT slides**

1. Font types and size should be same: **Times New Roman 32**
2. Slides should be very very short: **No sentences to write** ; only **words/phrases**
3. **Come well prepared for viva; be precise & to the point**
4. **Speak loud & confident: Maintain eye contact**
5. **Post thesis viva needful correction as per (i) experts' (external & internal) comments**
6. **No bullets to use** ; use **Roman Number (i, ii) instead**
7. **14 slides (with slide number & date)**

Slide 5	<b>Conceptual framework</b>
Slide 6	<b>Limitations of the study (i, ii, iii, ...)</b>
Slide 7	<b>Research gap (how your thesis differs from previous theses)</b>
Slide 8	<b>8.1 Research Methodology (Research design, population, sampling etc.</b> <b>8.2 Research Methodology (Data sources, data collection, analysis tools)</b>
Slide 9	<b>9.1 Results (Summarized numerical values in master tables)</b> <b>9.2 Results (Summarized numerical values in master tables)</b> <b>9.3 Results (Summarized numerical values in master tables)</b>
Slide 10	<b>Major findings (Summary of results supported by data)</b>
Slide 11	<b>Discussion (if your findings support or contradict theories &amp; previous findings)</b>
Slide 12	<b>Conclusion (In alignment with purpose of the study, i, ii, iii, ...)</b>
Slide 13	<b>Implication (Recommendation to stakeholders like future researchers,</b>
